



JIMMY HAYNES

After serving four seasons as top defensive aide, Coach Jimmy Haynes moves into the head coaching spot for Pensacola High. No stranger to P.H.S. football fans, Coach Haynes was co-captain of Ernie Priest's 1940 squad.

The home grown mentor then went two years to Perkingston Junior College on a football scholarship before going into the service. Following his army tenure, he attended Western Kentucky on another football grant. During those two years, he played guard on the gridiron and centerfield on the ball diamond. He pursued his baseball career professionally for one season. He hit about .280 for Deland in 1947.

He entered the coaching and teaching ranks in 1948 at Russellville, Ky. High School. In three seasons as head coach he compiled a 25-5 record. From Russellville, Coach Haynes moved to Shawnee High, also in Kentucky, where his teams continued their winning ways.

In 1956, Coach Haynes answered the call for a defensive tutor at P.H.S. Returning home after a fifteen year absence, he showed his appreciation by molding some of P.H.S.'s stingiest defensive teams in a long time. When the Bengals became a two-platoon team in 1957, Coach Haynes' value was really stressed. In the last three years, the Tiger defensive squad, known as the "Headhunters," has yielded a total of 124 points; less than five points a game.
