## Music for our service today provided by classmate Richard Siegel

Richard Siegel, American harpsichordist, finished his musical studies in the United States and moved to France, where he won First Prizes in Harpsichord and Chamber Music at the Paris National Conservatory. In 1977, at the Paris International Harpsichord Competition, he was awarded First Prize in Figured Bass Realization.

Since then, Richard Siegel has pursued an international career as a soloist, with orchestra, and has played numerous concert tours: in Germany, Italy, Japan (22 times), the Far East, the United States; with the Ensemble Instrumental de France, the Mito Chamber Orchestra, and especially with the Jean-François Paillard Chamber Orchestra. He has accompanied soloists such as Gérard Jarry, Jean-Pierre Rampal, Shigenori Kudo, Philippe Pierlot, Michel Giboureau, etc., and with his various partners he has recorded over 30 CDs, including Henri Dutilleux' Second Symphony with Daniel Barenboim. He has appeared as soloist and played concertos with many of the major ensembles in France, and has also played and premiered a large number of contemporary works.

Recently retired, he was also devoted to teaching, as an assitant at the Paris Conservatory (C.N.S.M. de Paris), at the Sorbonne, and at the National Regional Conservatory at St. Maur des Fossés (Paris Region) and the Conservatory at Choisy le Roi. In 2002 he was awarded a "Fondation de France" prize (Prix Charles Oulmont) honoring his career. His harpsichord method in 4 volumes is published by Les Editions Alphonse Leduc.

A Sun article entitled "'Great Hopes' Die with Local Youth in Vietnam" reported, "The only Jewish Marine in his battalion, Cpl. Walensky never complained about a thing," his aunt said this week, "except that there was no hot food to eat. He lived on 'C' rations while in the field", she said.
