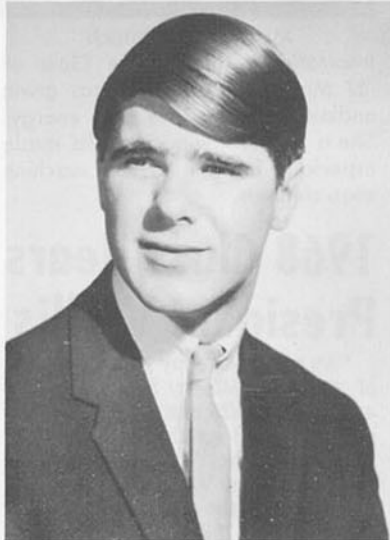


Seniors Tell Plans For Future In College, Work, Travel, Armed Forces

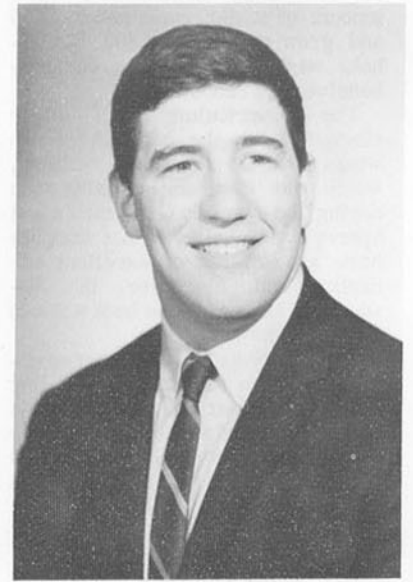
