Even if you are not able to attend the reunion, here is what is needed from you:

- For the sake of efficiency, please email us your email address.
- Go to our class website at ethsclassof62.com, look over the site, using the menu in the upper-right portion of the "Home" page.
- Contrary to past reunions, no reunion book will be printed for this reunion. Therefore, if you haven't already done so, go to the "Classmates" page, and create your username and password. This process will confirm that we have found you.
- Find your profile and your yearbook photo. Check your entry for accuracy, complete the items, and enter your comments. If there is no yearbook photo of you, please email us a photo of you from about 1962 We will input your photo for you.
- This profile section on the website is where you will learn about your classmates and will effectively be your "reunion book."
- Write down and secure your login information.
- This "Classmates" section is the only password-protected section of our website.
- Please review the updated "Missing & Unconfirmed List" on the
 website. Please email us any contact information you have. Our goal
 is to give every classmate the opportunity to attend this reunion.
- There will be a limited number of complimentary tee shirts, panoramic photos, and reunion books from previous reunions.
- The "In Memory" section on the website has been updated and includes submitted tributes. Consider posting a tribute about a special friend.

For those planning to attend the reunion, here is what is needed from you:

- Book your lodging (scroll down for lodging details).
- If you live in the Chicago area but some distance from Evanston, treat yourself to a hotel and avoid the commute.
- So we can arrange meals, print name tags with your yearbook photo, and plan other details, **buy your reunion ticket(s) now via the website.**
- Bring memorabilia items and copies of old photos, including class/group photos from grade school, etc.

 Prior to the reunion, ticket holders will receive one further communication, detailing the final plans for the weekend which are still being "polished."

Lodging information:

As previously communicated to you, we had blocked rooms at four local hotels. The rate for a single occupancy or a double occupancy is the same: \$199 per night

The special room rates at the **Doubletree** (a Hilton Hotel in Skokie near Old Orchard Shopping Center) will expire at 11:59 p.m., Thursday, April 5.

The rate for a single or a double occupancy is the same: \$169 per night

Email us so we can email you the special reservation link to book one of these limited number of blocked rooms at our negotiated room rates at the **Doubletree**.

"Email/Letter #1" and "Email/Letter #2" and "Email/Letter #3" are posted on our class reunion website (ETHSclassof62.com), though the website will <u>not</u> show lodging information. Lodging information is above and at the end of this email.

For your convenience and for your easy reference, the following information is from past emails:

Forgot your password to complete your profile?

You will need to use the same device for both parts of a password-reset request.

- **1.** Go to https://ethsclassof62.com/classmates.
- 2. Click on "Forgot Password," and type in your email address.
- **3.** Using the same device, go to your email, and follow the steps to set up a new password.
- **4.** Return to https://ethsclassof62.com/classmates, and type in your username, which is your email address and the password you have just set.

How to upload a current photo to your profile (on a Windows PC):

Go to your yearbook photo in the profile page on the website, and click above it where it says, "To create or modify your profile click here." (This text is in green.)

- 1. Scroll down to Images.
- 2. At the "Now Photo" section, click "Browse."
- **3.** This link will take you to where you have your own photos stored on your computer.
- 4. Click on the photo you want to upload.
- **5.** Then, click "Open."

Your new photo should now appear with your profile on the reunion website.

If you have any trouble, you can email us the photo, and we will upload it to your profile.

Do I need a rental car?

You do <u>not</u> need to rent a car. Most of the hotels and the reunion events are in the downtown Evanston area (except for a tour of the high school on Saturday afternoon).

If you need or want to travel someplace, use an Uber, a Lyft, or a cab.

Transportation between O'Hare and Evanston:

The best "deal" is the new Pulse Dempster Line, an express bus route between O'Hare Airport and downtown Evanston. To learn more about this express bus service, Goggle: Pulse Dempster Line Route

The cost is only \$2.25.

The average travel time is 50 minutes, depending on the time of day.

Reunion Festivities:

- For those who arrive on Thursday, Sept. 19, we are in the process of lining up a restaurant for people to gather, order food off the menu, socialize, etc.

Lodging Details:

The best information for blocked & discounted hotels is toward the beginning of this email, with deadlines for blocked & discounted rooms spelled out. The following information was from prior reunion letters (appropriately updated):

Make your lodging arrangements in or near downtown Evanston. There are seven hotels listed, two of which are near Old Orchard. However, as a matter of convenience, we recommend one of the five hotels (or possibly a VRBO or an Airbnb) in downtown Evanston.

Below are lodging suggestions in Evanston and the surrounding area.

To obtain a possible better room rate, we encourage you to visit the hotel information below, though it might turn out that the blocked-room rates mentioned at the beginning of this email are better:

- Visit the hotel website rather than talking with a hotel reservations person on the phone.
- Investigate a hotel reservation service, such as Booking.com, Travelocity.com, Expedia.com, Hotels.com, etc.
- Alternatives to a hotel: VRBO.com and Airbnb.com
