# President's Message



Dear Fellow KidneyTexas Members,

September is almost here and by the time you read this Newsletter, you will have received the 2023 Luncheon and Fashion Show invitation to be held Tuesday September 26th at the Brook Hollow Golf Club. Our hats are off to Chair, **Venise Stuart**, for her experience and leadership in organizing KidneyTexas signature event! **Jan Strimple** Fashion Show will leave us eager to shop, **Scott Murray** Emcee charm will shine and fabulous auction items will dazzle! KidneyTexas is celebrating its 24th year of hosting its annual fundraiser for designated beneficiaries and

awareness for kidney disease. This year the beneficiaries are the **Children's Medical Center Foundation**, **Methodist Health System Foundation**, **Texas Health Resources** and **Camp Reynal-National Kidney Foundation**. There are three additional worthwhile potential beneficiaries on contingency whose funding depends on KidneyTexas exceeding its luncheon fundraising goal. Due to little overhead, we are proud that a majority percentage of donations/funds raised goes directly to our beneficiaries! Just know with your luncheon attendance and support, you will be part of helping a person with kidney disease.

Please note that our website has been updated particularly with kidney statistics, history and 2023 schedule plus other sections. The current kidney statistics have been researched and verified. Thanks go to the Southwest Transplant Alliance Epidemiologist for their input. Did you know that there are currently 88,663 people on the national kidney transplant wait list and 8,294 Texans on the wait list. There were 2,394 kidney transplants performed in Texas during 2022. As of May 2023, The CDC estimates that about one in seven adults or 35.5million people have chronic kidney disease in the US. As there are not enough donors, research and early stages of kidney disease detection is crucial. The most recent pig kidney transplant experiment in a brain dead patient is performing all of the bodily functions of a healthy kidney for a month. This is the longest a pig kidney has worked in a person and now waiting to see if the kidney can last a second month. This may be the threshold for those who thought they had no hope. In our small way, KidneyTexas exists to help fund our seven Dallas medical facilities. Since 1999, KidneyTexas has raised \$4.6 million with proceeds from our 2023 fundraiser and donations to be added to this figure.

The updated 2023 Schedule of Events on our website shows an Orientation Meeting for new KidneyTexas members has been squeezed into the schedule. This aligns with our theme this year of Cultivate and Educate. Educating our members (and community) on kidney disease and its effects makes us better advocates. Even Texas State **Senator Hancock** who had a Kidney transplant with a match from his son in law has filed a bill that if passed, would try to increase the number of organs available for donation through education programs on becoming a living donor. "He hopes to make sure that others on transplant lists have a chance of finding a match especially if they aren't as fortunate as he was to have a family that did." Hancock's bill passed the Senate and is in the House Public Health Committee. Stay tune for its outcome.

### **HLA Cross Match Test Update**

New Development in evaluating highly sensitized patients waiting for a kidney transplant. Patients with ESRD who are being evaluated for a possible transplant are always tested for HLA antibodies. The number of antibodies that are found contribute to a cPRA percentage, which is an indication of how many donors are compatible. So called, "highly sensitized" patients, or those with many antibodies have a high cPRA. Patients with a cPRA >98% may wait for many, many years before a compatible donor is found.

Recent scientific studies have indicated that some HLA antibodies detected by the most common test used may not be clinically relevant. That is, they may represent a false positive result of the test and have no adverse impact on a transplanted organ. There are additional tests available that may help identify which antibodies are false positive.

It is possible that by simply adding an additional test for HLA antibodies to help identify false positives, the availability of a compatible donor can be significantly increased for highly sensitized patients. Additional studies are needed to quantify the number of patients that would be impacted and by how much the wait time may be shortened, but it is possible that hundreds of patients in Texas alone, could benefit from this additional information.
