### General Information and Instructions

Each person attending convention must fill out a **separate** online registration form and pay with a debit/credit card. Optional online tickets are available for appetizers at the Friday night Meet and Greet, the 50-Year Luncheon, and the Projects Night Dinner, as well as housing and extra programs for the convention sessions. ### Information for Convention Check-In and Check-Out

Convention check-in will take place on Friday, May 17 from 11:00 am - 5:00 p.m. near the side entrance to the Riverside Hotel. All P.E.O. sisters should be prepared to show their current P.E.O. membership card.

Riverside Hotel room keys can be picked up at the Registration Desk in the main lobby of the hotel. **Check-in is at 4:00 p.m.**, but you may check in early if your room is ready. Early arrivals may leave their luggage at the registration desk. **Check-out is at 11:00 a.m.**

### Chapter Delegates - Items to Bring

- Current membership card and your P.E.O. emblem.
- **Seven copies** of your Chapter Yearbook in a Zip-lock bag.
- Your Travel Equalization statement if you are due to receive funds.

- A **REQUIRED** finance workshop will be held on Saturday at 8:00 a.m. (open to all P.E.O.s).
- A **REQUIRED** Orientation for all members of convention will take place on Saturday at 8:30 a.m. (open to all P.E.O.s).

### Information for BILs, Visitors, and Guests

Only P.E.O.s are entitled to attend convention sessions. Everyone is welcome to attend the Friday Night Meet and Greet, and those who register online may enjoy the hors d'oeuvres. Online registration is also necessary to attend the 50-Year Luncheon and the Project's Night dinner. Meal tickets will be distributed at the convention check-in location on Friday and 30 minutes prior to each event. Activities for BILs and Guests will be available on Saturday. ### Expenses

- Each chapter delegate and PPISC are assessed a \$50.00 registration fee. Local chapters should reimburse their delegates for this amount.
- Local chapters should pay for their 50-year members to attend the Luncheon. 50-year members should pay for their invited guests.
- Local chapters should pay for their delegate's travel expenses and reasonable room upgrades.
