<u>Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinay Time</u>: In my homily this weekend I shall mention the encyclical *Quas Primas* from Pope Pius XI, promulgated in 1925. I have summarised the salient points below and would encourage you to read the actual document which can be found online at <u>https://www.vatican.va/content/pius-xi/en/encyclicals/documents/hf_p-xi_enc_11121925_quas-primas.pdf</u>

- 1. Christ's Sovereignty
 - Jesus Christ is declared King of the universe.

- His reign is not just spiritual but has implications for political, social, and economic life.

- 2. The Feast of Christ the King
 - Instituted to remind the world of Christ's authority over all.
 - Intended to counter secularism and remind people of their duty to God.
- 3. Secularism and Its Dangers
 - Critiques the growing secularism and its impact on society.

- Warns against the exclusion of God from public life and the consequent moral decay.

- 4. Call to Return to Christian Principles
 - Advocates for a return to Christian values in personal and public life.
 - Emphasizes the need for justice, charity, and the common good.
- 5. Role of the Catholic Church
 - Asserts the Church's role in guiding moral and social matters.
 - Calls on Catholics to promote Christ's teachings in society.
- 6. Impact on Social and Economic Issues
 - Highlights the need for economic systems to be just and equitable.
 - Encourages respect for human dignity and the protection of workers' rights.
