

33rd Edition of the Défi Canderel Challenge Raises over \$2.26 Million for Cancer Research

Montreal, January 1, 2023 – Canderel raised over \$2.26 million for cancer research through its corporate philanthropic endeavour, the Défi Canderel Challenge. These funds were divided between the Défi Canderel's two beneficiary research centres: the Institut du cancer de Montréal of the Université de Montréal and the Rosalind & Morris Goodman Cancer Institute of McGill University.

Since 1989, Canderel has been dedicating efforts and resources to support Canadian university research centres. In 33 years, over \$24 million have been raised through this annual corporate fundraising campaign. The donated funds have been invested in various ways, including: the funding of innovative research projects, often in close collaboration with centres across the country; the creation and awarding of scholarships, fellowships and bursaries for students and researchers; the purchase of state-of- the-art equipment and technology; and the funding of other urgent priority needs.
